THE UINTA SCHOLARSHIP



This scholarship is awarded annually to one premier dancer. The scholarship can be used to offset the cost of dance lessons, competition fees, travel, and dance costumes/equipment. The scholarship is administered by the student's dance instructor. The dollar amount is variable and Dependant on available funds.

ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS:

- Candidates must be a Premier level dancer.
- Candidates are required to be a member of the MWHDA, as well as a student under a certified and MWHDA registered instructor.
- Candidates must participate in at least one MWHDA sponsored performance, competition, or development workshop within the application year.
- Candidates will be asked to perform an original choreography at the year-end Winter Tartan Ball. The dance needs to be based on Highland Dancing Technique. The choreography may be performed to Celtic or non-Celtic music and may integrate other dance forms and techniques. The choreography should be 2-3 minutes in length.
- Candidates will be evaluated by members of the MWHDA board and MWHDA instructors.
- The scholarship will be awarded to the most promising dancer based on their effort, determination, and skill.

Deadline: To be considered, you'll need to apply by the end of February for the scholarships awarded at the end of the same year.
